

**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On or about March 23, 2015, the City of Central Falls City Council as Board of License Commissioners (“Board”) denied an application to transfer its liquor license from Pleitez and Ramos Family, Inc. d/b/a Restaurant Delis (“Appellant”). Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 3-7-21, the Appellant appealed the Board’s decision to the Director of the Department of Business Regulation (“Department”). On or about April 7, 2015, the undersigned was appointed the hearing officer by the Director of the Department. A pre-hearing conference was held on April 22, 2015. On or about February 9, 2016, the parties notified the undersigned that this matter had been resolved so that the appeal could be dismissed. Therefore, based on the forgoing, the Appellant’s appeal is dismissed.




