ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On or about April 16, 2006, an Order to Cease and Desist Unauthorized Loan Brokering Activities and a Notice of Intention to Revoke License under R.I. Gen. Laws § 19-14-13 and of Opportunity for Hearing was issued to the above-captioned Respondents. The undersigned was appointed substitute hearing officer on April 27, 2009. On or about October 5, 2009, Respondents' counsel indicated that the licenseholder was out of business and the license at issue surrendered. The undersigned requested confirmation of the surrender of license and that was not disputed by the Department. On November 4, 2010, the undersigned informed the parties that in light of the surrender, she would recommend dismissal of this matter and requested any objections be submitted by November 19, 2010. No objection was received by November 19, 2010. To date, no objection has been received.

Therefore, I find that the Respondents have surrendered their license(s) and they shall cease and desist any unauthorized loan brokering activities, and this matter shall be dismissed.
