**CONSENT AGREEMENT**

The Division of Commercial Licensing (“Division”) of the Rhode Island Department of Business Regulation (“Department”) enters into this Consent Agreement (“Agreement”) with Respondent Donna F. Millette (“Respondent”) to resolve the above-captioned matter pursuant to its authority under R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-9(d).


It is hereby agreed by and between the Division and the Respondent that:

1. The Department granted an Operations Employee License to Respondent that authorized her employment as a “Cage and Count” cashier at Twin River Casino (“License”) pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 41-4-9.1(c).
2. Respondent admits that she was terminated from said employment on May 28, 2013, but contests the grounds for said termination.
3. Respondent does not admit or deny any facts underlying the termination.



4. Respondent admits that, as of the date of this Agreement, the underlying facts are the subject of a criminal proceeding in which Respondent has pleaded "Not Guilty." (Case ID number 61-2013-05447).
5. Respondent agrees to voluntarily surrender the License to the Department effective as of the date of this Agreement.
6. This surrender shall be considered permanent and irrevocable on December 31, 2015, the expiration of the license term.
7. Prior to expiration, the Respondent may petition the Division to reinstate her license, but only if she obtains an offer of re-employment for the same position described in paragraph 1.
8. Respondent understands that any offer of employment for a different position will require Respondent to submit a new application rather than a petition for reinstatement. This Agreement shall not prejudice Respondent's right to do so.
9. In considering any petition for reinstatement, the Division shall consider the facts underlying the termination, the outcome of the subject criminal proceedings, and any other information bearing on the suitability of the Respondent for licensure. If the Division intends to deny said petition, the Respondent shall be provided with notice and an opportunity to be heard before a Hearing Officer appointed by the Director of the Department.
10. In consideration of the foregoing, the Division agrees to withdraw its Order to Show Cause dated May 30, 2013.
11. By signing this Agreement, Respondent acknowledges and understands that, with respect to the voluntary surrender of the License, she voluntarily waives any right to an

administrative hearing or appeal to Superior Court under the Rhode Island Administrative Procedures Act, R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-1 *et seq.* This shall not constitute a waiver of the hearing that may be conducted pursuant to paragraph 9 herein.
