

NOTICE

Effective June 21, 2007 Rhode Island General Law §41-4-9.1 entitled Licensing of concessioners, vendors and pari-mutuel totalizator companies was amended to allow for the issuance of a three-year license to be implemented on a graduated basis. The fees for these licenses are as follows:

Gaming Facility Employees:

For the remainder of 2007 new license fees shall be prorated to one-third of the above amounts. Example, Operations employees will be charged \$50.00 and Concessionaires and vendors will be charged \$250.00 to file a new application. All licenses issued shall expire on December 31, 2007. Thereafter licenses will be issued on a staggered three-year cycle where one-third of all licenses will be licensed annually for a three-year period.
