Attorney Continuing Education Update –

New Requirements Effective January 1, 2022

Issued: January 11, 2022

This Bulletin is applicable to all Real Estate Licensees of the Department of Business Regulation (“Department”) pursuant to [R.I. Gen. Laws § 5-20.5](#) and [230-RICR-30-20-02](#), the Real Estate Brokers and Salespersons Regulation.

Recent amendments to R.I.G.L. § 5-20.5-6 d state, in part:

“An attorney at law licensed by the supreme court of the state and granted a license pursuant to § 5-20.5-4(d) is not subject to the continuing education requirements”

As such, attorneys are no longer required to take continuing education and should select the exemption provided when submitting their renewal application.
