

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

Upon inspection, this work was deemed improper because :

NO Permits pulled, project involved Building, Plumbing and Electrical work that would've required Permits and Inspections.

Overall this is a case of attention to detail on all areas that were touched and or left in an unfinished, aesthetically less than what would be expected, I.E. uneven floor tiling, 1/8 to 1/4" raised edges, uneven feel under foot. The lack of prep and protection of flooring shows signs of staining, grout staining etc.

The shower stall was left with open and exposed areas where the tiling and or grout was improperly installed or applied.

"Purple" PVC pipe glue staining on the laundry appliances, with no piping above or near the appliances?.
