Description

On or about May 17, 2022, Raymond Bagley of Bagley's Landscape Construction LLC, the respondent, began work at 105 Fern St, Warwick, which consisted the removal and building of residential egress steps and a masonry walkway. This work is of the type which requires registration with the CRLB. A check of the registration database showed that the respondent was not registered.

Violation

5-65-3(m) - Failure to secure permits prior to commencing work

Violation Penalty

Description

On July 22, 2022, I reviewed the work done by the respondent at 105 Fern St, Warwick. Upon examination, I noticed the steps were not built in accordance with SBC2. There was variation of step/riser height more than 3/4 inch. Because the steps lead into the home, they are considered means of egress and a building permit is required to be secured prior to starting work. A check of the permitting database shows that no permits were issued for this by the City of Warwick.

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5-65-18 - Failure to provide mechanic's lien notice

Violation Penalty

250

Description

Contracts for work require notice that the contractor provide the consumer with a notice that the contractor may file a lien in accordance with the Mechanic' Lien Law, as found in R.I. Gen. Law 34-28. Upon review of the written contract, the required notice was absent from the contract.

Fine amount: \$1,750

Because you did not request a hearing within the time allowed, the Proposed Order has converted to a Final Order. The fines, as listed above, are now due and payable. If payment is not received within twenty (20) days, your case may be referred to the Office of the Attorney General for criminal prosecution pursuant to RIGL § 5-65-19.
