Disciplinary Action - Violation # V-6633

This letter serves to notify you that the Rhode Island Contractors' Registration and Licensing Board(CRLB) has determined that on or about December 27, 2021, at 43 Truman Street, Johnston, RI 02919 violations of the following section(s) of Rhode Island General Laws were discovered and the CRLB intends to assess civil penalties as proposed.

#### Violation

5-65-3(j) - Hiring of non-registered subcontractor

#### **Violation Penalty**

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1,000

#### Description

On or about 12/27/22 the contractor started a construction project at 43 Truman St Johnston. According to the contractor, "I used day laborers with relative experience who work as independent contractors."

This work is of the type which requires registration with the CRLB. The contractor provided the names and addresses of sub-contractors that are not registered as required.

#### Violation

5-65-3(m) - Failure to secure permits prior to commencing work

#### **Violation Penalty**

1,000

#### Description

On or about 12/27/22 the contractor started a project for construction that included;

Bathroom fan/light and vanity light.

Remove existing and install new kitchen window.

Wall Board and plaster basement areas as follows: hallway including old kitchen area, Bathroom, Bedroom ceiling.

Replace in kind, 60" shower unit, Toilet, vanity, light fixture/fan

Remove the existing window in the old kitchen and replace it with a new side slide window.

Install new plumbing fixtures and shut off valves in the kitchen and basement bath.

This work is of the type which requires that a building, electrical, or plumbing permit be taken out prior to commencing work. Upon request, the respondent could not produce the required permit.

#### Violation

5-65-18 - Failure to provide mechanic's lien notice

## **Violation Penalty**

250

# Description

Contracts for work require notice that the contractor provide the consumer with a notice that the contractor may file a lien in accordance with the Mechanic' Lien Law, as found in R.I. Gen. Law 34-28. Upon review of the written contract, for 43 Truman st., the required notice was absent from the contract.

### Violation

5-65-10(a)(12) - Contractor performed improper work

# **Violation Penalty**

250

#### Description

On or about 12/27/21, respondent performed a kitchen and basement remodel project. Upon inspection, this work was deemed improper because;

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The respondent used a 9v smoke alarm to cover a kitchen light box. This device is not listed for this purpose. In addition, a smoke alarm should not be installed in proximity to a stove.

He also left a smoke alarm hanging by its wires in the hallway.

Fine amount: \$2,500

You have the right to a hearing. You must request a hearing in writing, to the Contractors' Registration Board, 560 Jefferson Blvd, Warwick, RI 02886 within twenty (20) days of the date of this mailing or issuance of the Notice of Intent to Assess Civil Penalty. Failure to apply for, or to attend a scheduled hearing, will result in the issuance of a Final Order.
