**Description**

On May 18, 2022, at approximately 2:00 pm, I observed workers installing an architectural asphalt shingle roof on a residential structure, located at 157 Harrison Ave, Newport. This work is of the type which requires registration with the CRLB. When asked for proof of registration, the workers stated they were hired by Bermol Construction, the respondent. A check of the registration database showed that Bermol Construction did not hold an registration with the CRLB.

5-65-3(j) - Hiring of non-registered subcontractor

**Violation Penalty**

1,000

**Description**

On May 18, 2022, at approximately 2:00 pm, I observed workers installing an architectural asphalt shingle roof on a residential structure, located at 157 Harrison Ave, Newport. This work is of the type which requires registration with the CRLB. When asked for proof of registration, the workers, identified as Matzatz Construction LLC, stated they were not registered. Upon further inquiry, I learned that the workers had been hired by Miguel Bermol, the respondent, to perform work.

Fine amount: \$3,500

Because you did not request a hearing within the time allowed, the Proposed Order has converted to a Final Order. The fines, as listed above, are now due and payable. If payment is not received within twenty (20) days, your case may be referred to the Office of the Attorney General for criminal prosecution pursuant to RIGL § 5-65-19.

Alternatively, you may appeal this Final Order in writing, within twenty (20) days of the date of this mailing to the Contractors' Registration and Licensing Board.
