On or about November 14, 2022 , you were provided with a Notice of Violation/Proposed Order, a copy of which is attached and incorporated as if stated again in full, that the Rhode Island Contractors' Registration and Licensing Board determined that you were in violation of Rhode Island General Laws and intended to assess civil penalties.

**RE: NOTICE OF INTENT TO ASSESS CIVIL PENALTY AND OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING –  
PROPOSED ORDER**  
Disciplinary Action - Violation # V-6742

This letter serves to notify you that the Rhode Island Contractors' Registration and Licensing Board (CRLB) has determined that on or about November 10, 2022, at 16 Waterman Lake Drive, Glocester, RI 02814 violations of the following section(s) of Rhode Island General Laws were discovered and the CRLB intends to assess civil penalties as proposed.

**Violation**

5-65-3(m) - Failure to secure permits prior to commencing work

**Violation Penalty**

2,500

**Description**

On 8/5/22, extending access to the basement via interior space and replace siding was underway at 16 Waterman Lake Drive, Glocester. This work is of the type which requires that a building permit be issued prior to commencing work. Ken Johnson, building official for Glocester, informed the CRLB via email that no permits were applied for at the property.

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**Violation**

5-65-10(a)(11) - Breach of contract

**Violation Penalty**

1,000

**Description**

The respondent (Michael Verrier) entered into a contract with Alecia Baran for to perform work that included extending access to the basement via interior space and replace siding. On 11/10/22 the homeowner filed a complaint with the CRLB alleging, in pertinent part, that the Respondent had breached the contract. The review of the correspondence indicates the contractor did not fulfill the agreement in the contract to complete the work. The contractor walked away from the job 10/3/22, leaving the property exposed to the elements, and has not returned to the property.

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**Violation**

5-65-10(a)(14) - Failure to complete a project(s) for construction or willfully failed to comply with the terms of a contract or written warranty.

**Violation Penalty**

2,500

**Description**

On or about 7/29/22 the homeowner and respondent entered into an agreement to extend access to the basement via interior space and replace siding at 16 Waterman Lake Drive, Glocester. The Respondent was paid in full for this work and failed to complete the work. On or about 10/3/22 the Respondent ceased performing work prior to the completion of the project and has not returned or returned any calls from the homeowner.

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**Violation**

5-65-18 - Failure to provide mechanic's lien notice

**Violation Penalty**

500

**Description**

Contracts for work require notice that the contractor provide the consumer with a notice that the contractor may file a lien in accordance with the Mechanic' Lien Law, as found in R.I. Gen. Law 34-28. Upon review of the written contract, the required notice was absent from the contract.

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Fine amount: \$6,500

You have the right to a hearing. You must request a hearing in writing, to the Contractors' Registration Board, 560 Jefferson Blvd, Warwick, RI 02886 within twenty (20) days of the date of this mailing or issuance of the Notice of Intent to Assess Civil Penalty. Failure to apply for, or to attend a scheduled hearing, will result in the issuance of a Final Order.
