

FINAL ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter arose from an appeal filed by East Side Restaurant Holdings, LLC d/b/a Sports & Leisure (“Appellant”) with the Department of Business Regulation (“Department”) pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 3-7-21 regarding the decision taken on June 14, 2023 by the City of Providence, Board of Licenses (“Board”) imposing discipline on the Appellant’s Class BV liquor license. After a hearing held on October 3, 2023, the Department issued a decision on December 5, 2023 remanding the matter to the Board for further proceedings. After the Board heard the matter on remand, the Appellant notified the Department on March 31, 2024 that it was appealing the remand decision. Prior to a hearing on the further appeal, the parties resolved this matter. On November 6, 2024, the parties submitted a consent order to the undersigned resolving said appeal. Therefore, based on the foregoing, the Appellant’s appeal is dismissed.
