On or about February 14, 2024 , you were provided with notice that the Rhode Island Contractors' Registration and Licensing Board determined that you were in violation of the following section(s) of Rhode Island General Law and intended to assess civil penalties as proposed

Violation

5-65-3(j) - Hiring of non-registered subcontractor

Violation Penalty

250

Description

A check of the CRLB Registration database showed that LA Construction and Masonry was not registered with the CRLB. Upon further inquiry, I learned that these workers had been hired to perform the work at 324 Mount Pleasant Ave, Providence by the respondent.

Violation

5-65-3(o) - Failure to have written contract when work performed is in excess of \$1,000.00

Violation Penalty

250

Description

Respondent entered in an agreement to perform work at 324 Mount Pleasant Ave, Providence on or about 11/29/2023. The amount paid to the respondent totaled \$16,000.00. Upon request, the complainant stated they were not provided a written contract.

Violation

5-65-10(a)(10) - Performed work, or arranged to perform work, without a valid registration.

Violation Penalty

1,000

Description

Upon review of the complaint C-23-474 it was discovered that concrete repairs was underway at 324 Mount Pleasant Ave, Providence. This work is of the type which requires registration with the CRLB. A check of the CRLB Registration database showed that LA Construction and Masonry was not registered with the CRLB.

Fine amount: \$1,500

Because you did not request a hearing within the time allowed, the Proposed Order has converted to a Final Order. The fines, as listed above, are now due and payable. If payment is not received within twenty (20) days, your case may be referred to the Office of the Attorney General for criminal prosecution pursuant to RIGL § 5-65-19.
