CONSENT AGREEMENT

The Department of Business Regulation ("Department"), by and through the Contractors' Licensing and Registration Board ("CRLB"), and Jose Arias ("Respondent")(collectively hereinafter, the "Parties") hereby consent and agree to the following:

- 1. On or about September 21, 2022, Complainant and Respondent entered into a written contract for the partial roof replacement and repair at the Site, after which the roof leaked in various parts of the home and the Respondent would not return her calls for addressing the faulty work.
- 2. The Complainant submitted the contract she and Respondent entered into for repair of the roof. The document is handwritten, states its title as "Contract Agreement," and states the work is "...for fixing the porch R side, Roof and patching some Holes on the top of The House Roof," for the price of four thousand dollars (\$4,000) ("Contract").
- 3. The Contract further states that "Guarantee Promise to call if any leak in Roof and Porch Roof to be fixed and patched without any payments from [Complainant]." The Contract is signed by the Complainant and Respondent.
- 4. The Complainant took pictures and video of the water leaks and damage that clearly show the water leaks and damage.
- 5. On October 20, 2022, a CRLB Investigator made a Site visit and observed that the portion of the home over which the Respondent performed work, an enclosed porch converted into a bedroom, contained significant water damage as did other parts of the home.
- 6. As part of his investigation, the CRLB Investigator confirmed from the Providence permit database that Respondent obtained no permits for the Site work prior to beginning the Site work.

- 7. The Contract contained no mechanic's lien notice.
- 8. On October 21, 2022, the CRLB issued the Respondent a *Notice of Intent to Assess Civil Penalty and Opportunity for Hearing Proposed Order* Disciplinary Action Violation # V-6731 ("Notice").
- 9. On October 25, 2022, the CRLB received the Notice appeal request from Respondent.

STATEMENT OF LAW

10. Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 5-65-3(m):

The contractor must see that permits required by the state building code are secured on behalf of the owner prior to commencing the work involved. The contractor's registration number must be affixed to the permit as required by the state building code.

- 11. Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 5-65-3(o), contracts for work performed over one-thousand dollars must be in writing and must contain a notice of possible mechanic's lien.
- 12. Pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 5-65-10, "[t]he board or office may revoke, suspend, or refuse to issue, reinstate or reissue a registration if the board or office determines, after notice and an opportunity for a hearing:
 - (1) That the registrant or applicant has violated § 5-65-3 or any other provision of this chapter or the regulations promulgated thereunder.

(11) That the registrant breached a contract.

- (12) That the registrant performed negligent and/or improper work.
- (14) That the registrant has failed to complete a project(s) for construction or willfully failed to comply with the terms of a contract or written warranty.

CONDITIONS

- 13. In an effort to affect a timely and amicable resolution of the issues raised in this Consent Agreement without an administrative hearing, the Parties enter into this Consent Agreement solely for the purposes of avoiding the burdens and expenses of litigation. The Department agrees that it will not pursue revocation or suspension of Respondent's CRLB registration based on the content of this Consent Agreement, pursuant to the following terms and conditions:
 - a. Respondent admits and agrees that he did not obtain the appropriate and requisite permits for work he performed at the Site and the Contract entered into between Respondent and Complainant did not contain a mechanic's lien, both in violation of R.I. Gen. Laws § 5-65-3;

- As a result of Respondent's admissions in paragraph 13(a), Respondent shall deliver to the CRLB an administrative fine in the amount of two-hundred and fifty dollars (\$250.00) made payable to "Rhode Island General Treasurer" on or before June 20, 2024;
- c. The Respondent shall complete ten (10) continuing education credit hours, selected from a pre-approved CRLB list of courses, and shall verify the completion of said hours to the CRLB by or before **August 31, 2024**; and
- d. Respondent enters into this Consent Agreement knowingly, voluntarily and of his own free will.
- 14. *Final Determination*. The parties agree that this Consent Agreement and its terms represent the final determination of this matter.
- 15. Waiver of Hearing and Appeal. By agreeing to resolve this matter through the execution of this Consent Agreement, Respondent knowingly and voluntarily waives any right to an administrative hearing and waives any right to pursue an appeal to the Superior Court under the Rhode Island Administrative Procedures Act, R.I. Gen. Laws § 42-35-1, et seq.
- 16. Enforcement. If Respondent fails to comply with any term or condition of this Consent Agreement within any applicable time period set forth herein, the Respondent will be in violation hereunder and, upon ten (10) days written notice to Respondent, the Board shall be entitled to resume and continue the administrative action before the Hearing Officer assigned to this matter pursuant to the NOH.
- 17. Compliance; Laws. Compliance with the terms of this Consent Agreement does not relieve Respondent of any obligation to comply with other applicable laws or regulations administered by or through the Department of any other governmental agency.
