



Unpackaged Hemp-Derived Consumables Information Requirements

All Hemp Derived CBD Products sold outside of a prepackaged container should have corresponding Certificate of Analysis and pertinent information available to a consumer in physical, digital, or visual form (monitors/screens, physical paper or board menu)

All packaging and labeling information required for packaged hemp products must be available to consumers at point of sale. This could be on a pamphlet, a digital reference/QR code, or receipt.

Packaging leaving a licensed premises must:

- Be opaque and light resistant
- Fully enclose the product
- Protect the product from contamination
- Be Child-Resistant (*packaged in accordance with the Poison Prevention Packaging Act of 1970 (15 U.S.C. §§ 1471 – 75) and 16 C.F.R. Part 1700 et seq.*); and
- Not impart any toxic or deleterious substance to the hemp product

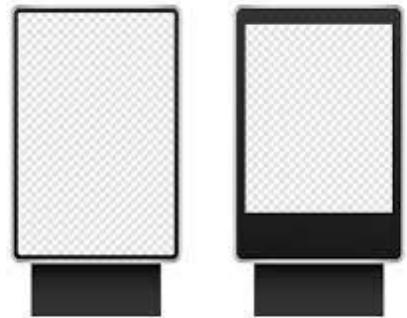


Unpackaged Hemp-Derived Consumables Consumer Information Requirements

Required Information to be Readily Available to Consumers:

1. The business(es) or tradename(s) and license number(s) of the licensee(s) who produced the product;
2. The business or tradename and license number of the licensee selling the product;
3. Unique identifier
4. Net weight of the product prior to its placement in the package (in ounces, grams, or volume as appropriate)
5. **Total THC and Total CBD**; (Must be in font larger than size 6, bolded, underlined and in red)
* Per Single Serving Consumables (Cannot exceed 1mg THC)
6. The serving size
7. If solvents were used in production, statement that discloses the type of extraction method, including any solvents, gases, or other chemicals or compounds used to produce or that are added to the extract
8. Any applicable instructions for use and safe storage; and
9. The required warning: "Warning: This product is not certified to be free of contaminants, is derived from industrial hemp, is not medical marijuana, and has not been analyzed or approved by the FDA."

All required Information must be unobstructed and conspicuous.

Unpackaged Hemp-Derived Consumables TO-GO Package Labeling Prohibitions

Font Requirements for Required Information:

- No smaller than size 6 font.
- Permitted Font Types: Times New Roman, Calibri, Arial, Helvetica or another font determined by the OCR to be easily readable
- Must be clearly written in the English language. Licensees may also include accurate text in a foreign language in addition to the required English text.

Prohibited on the Package Label:

1. Any medical claims
2. Anything that reasonably appears to target individuals under the age of twenty-one (21), including but not limited to:
 - Use of animal characters,
 - Toys,
 - Cartoon characters or
 - Similar images.
3. Any false or misleading statements including false or misleading statements regarding health or physical benefits or as to the composition and profiles
4. Any seal, flag, crest, coat of arms, or other insignia that could reasonably mislead any reasonably prudent person to believe that the product has been endorsed, produced or manufactured by the State of Rhode Island or any agency thereof or municipality within
5. Images of children or minors
6. Words, designs or brands that resemble a product that is commonly associated with children or minors or marketed to children or minors
7. Symbols or celebrities that are commonly used to market products to minors
8. Words or any reference to “candy” or “candies.”



Examples of prohibitions include, but are not limited to the following:



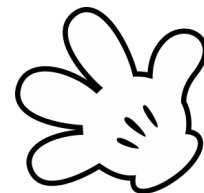
Animal characters, toys, cartoon characters, and images of children



Crest that looks like product is associated to state agency



Medical claims



Brand/symbol used to market to minors
