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

TEMPORARY CEASE AND DESIST ORDER

The above-entitled matter came before the undersigned pursuant to the Department of Business Regulation's ("Department") Emergency Order to Show Cause why Respondent Should not be Ordered to Immediately Cease and Desist; Notice of Hearing; and Appointment of Hearing Officer ("Notice") issued by the Department on September 17, 2024 to Jonathan Enright d/b/a JE Builders ("Respondent"). The Respondent is not registered as a contractor, and the Department alleges the Respondent acted a contractor in violation of the contractor registration statute, R.I. Gen. Laws § 5-65-1 *et seq.* The Respondent agreed to a cease and desist order without findings or admissions. Therefore, it is ordered as follows:

1. A temporary cease and desist order is entered against the Respondent so that the Respondent shall not engage in any activity for which registration is required as a contractor pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws § 5-65-1 *et seq.*
2. This order shall remain in effect until the resolution of this matter either by a decision after a full hearing or the parties resolve it without need for a hearing by consent order.
