PROPOSED ORDER OF DISMISSAL

1. This matter arose from an Order to Show Cause Why License Applications Should Not Be Denied, Notice of Pre-Hearing Conference and Appointment of Hearing Officer (“Order to Show Cause”) issued to the Respondent by the Department of Business Regulation (“Department”) in response to the Respondent’s request for an appeal hearing.
2. The Applications at issue pertain to a defined Premises as to which the Respondent and its Members have relinquished any custody or control.
3. The Respondent, through counsel, notified the Department that it withdrew its appeal.
4. The letter from the Department dated March 1, 2017, notifying the Respondent of the denial of the Applications and rescinding of the Preliminary Approval, remains in full force and effect.
5. The Department has notified the Respondent of its position that should the Respondent or any of its Members re-apply for any approvals from the Rhode Island Medical Marijuana Program, the allegations in the Order to Show Cause may be re-opened in a determination of suitability.




