

- The license is convertible to an equivalent traditional insurance producer license without an additional fee if the examination and background qualifications are met before its expiration date. There will be no extensions or exceptions to this requirement.
- The license does not qualify for a reciprocal non-resident license in any other state or jurisdiction.
- The license will not be issued unless the candidate can establish that (s)he is unable to take the required examination within a reasonable period of time due to verifiable extenuating circumstances. The Department will consider each of these requests on a case-by-case basis. Please note that no consideration will be given to a person that has taken and not passed the examination.

Instructions

- An individual may submit a request for consideration via email to dbr.inslic@dbr.ri.gov.

Persons who have been granted a temporary license should contact our licensing team upon passing the exam and submit a B.C.I. to dbr.inslic@dbr.ri.gov before the expiration of the temporary license (absolutely no exceptions). At which time our licensing team will convert the temporary license to a traditional RI insurance producer license without an additional fee
